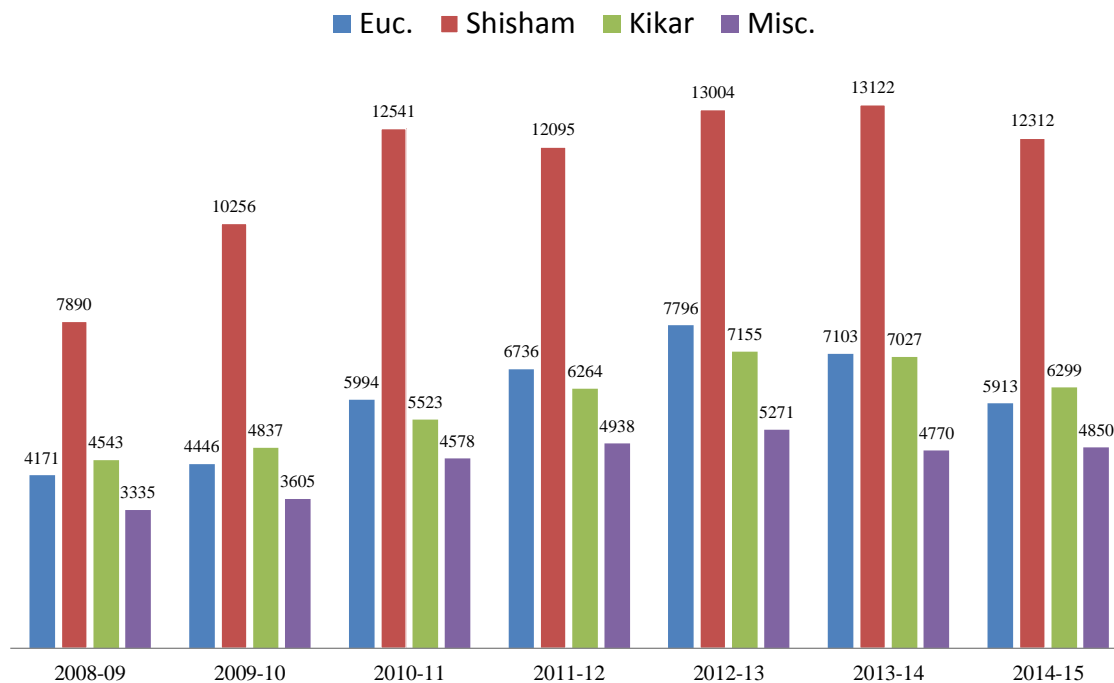
## Sale price of wood

### Furniture making units and saw mills

There are two departmental furniture workshops located one each at Yamunanagar and Karnal, where quality furniture from indigenous shisham wood as well as teak wood is manufactured. The furniture items include; office table, chairs, almirahs, beds, sofa sets, school benches and miscellaneous item. The other wood products manufactured at these workshops are; crates for storage of food grains, chowkhats, doors and windows used in construction. Haryana Government has declared Forest Department as an approved source for supply of furniture and other wood products to Govt. Departments. The annual turnover of wood products at Govt. workshops is to the tune of Rs. 5.0 crores.
