The Chief Vigilance Officer and the Vigilance Officers shall function in terms of directions/guidelines issued by the Chief Secretary, Haryana from time to time in this regard. The Chief Vigilance Officer and the Vigilance Officers shall be allocated work by the Government and they shall function accordingly unless determined by the Governor to be otherwise from time to time, the Vigilance Officers shall report to the Chief Vigilance Officers in respect of work allocated to them by the Government.



Subject: Preventive Vigilance/Role and Functions of the Chief Vigilance Officers.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention to para-9 of this department's letter No. 62/38/2014-6GS1, dated 1st January, 2015 vide which all the Administrative Departments/ Boards/Corporations were directed to create a dedicated Vigilance Wing and appoint a Chief Vigilance Officer who will act as the nodal officer for all vigilance related matters to root out corruption using preventive and participatory strategies. Thereafter, another letter dated 29th January, 2016 was sent to you that the Chief Vigilance Officer appointed should be an officer of appropriate level, preferably immediately below the Head of the Department. It has come to notice that some Departments have appointed very low rank officers as CVO, which renders the fight against corruption ineffective. In Engineering Departments, where construction/ technical matters are being handled, technical persons should be appointed as CVOs.

2. Accordingly, you are requested to appoint the CVOs as per instructions dated 29-1-16 of this department. The names of CVOs, address and mobile number be placed on the official web site of your respective Department/ Organization and an intimation in this regard be sent to this Department through

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e-mail at usvigilance@hry.nic.in as well as by hard copy within three days positively.

3. Further, the vigilance enquiries/complaints referred by this department to you and the complaints received in your Department/ Organization relating to corruption be supplied to this department on quarterly basis in the performa given below:-


