

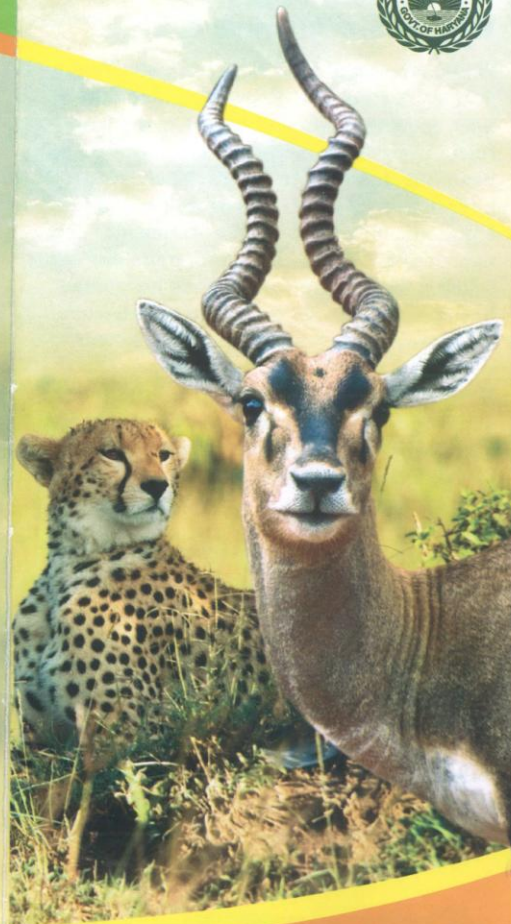

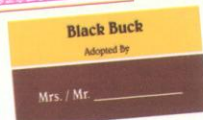


Privileges of Adoption

Procedure for adoption

One may adopt as under:

- Select a site of your choice, a zoo or the deer park
- Pick your favorite animal exhibited in the zoo as given in the list
- Choose your support for month/year
- Fill the form overleaf and hand it to the concerned zoo incharge
- You can gift an adopted animal to your family, friends and associates
- If in any case your favorite animal is already adopted, your name will be put in the waiting list, and as soon as the animal is available, you will be informed.

Note:

- A minimum of 10 birds shall have to be adopted.
- For the young ones of the above animals such as calves, cubs, chicks & fawns etc., the charges will be half of the above amount.
- Birds and Animals are subject to change.
- Cheque/DD to be made in the name of Chief Wildlife Warden Haryana Panchkula .
